Building Regenerative Societies

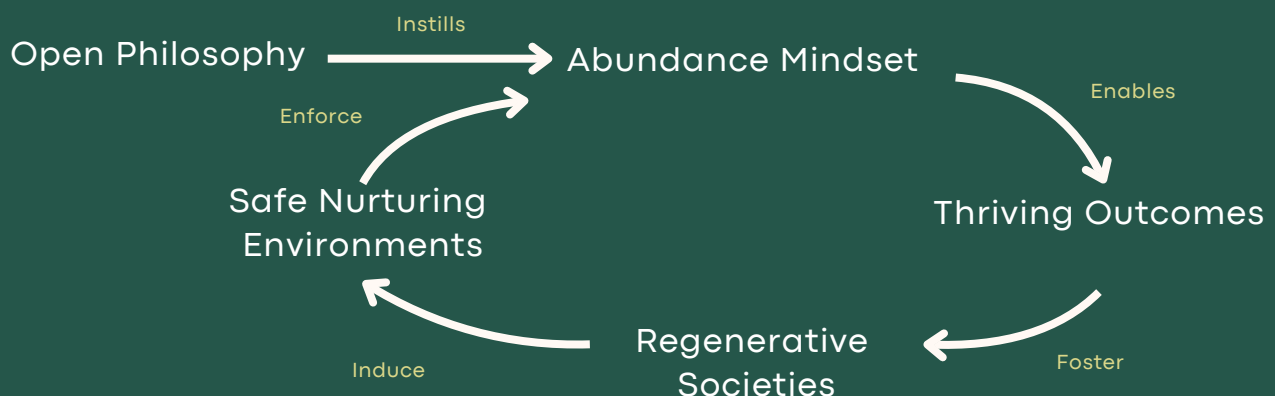
